General Information

1. Arrival

Teams will be met by liaison officer at Schiphol Airport, Eindhoven Airport, at the railway-station in Arnhem or at the barracks in Schaarsbergen.

At arrival immediately all teams must: fill in the check-in form at the info-office Make their ID card with photo

The ID card with picture will be issued to all participants. The ID card must be worn visibly during the championship.

2. Accommodation
